KICK-OFF CELEBRATION

Leaders of the Campaign and the Board of Generations of Indian Valley hosted a kickoff celebration for their \$1 million fundraising initiative on April 11, 2019 at Generations.

CENTER UPDATES

The campaign, dubbed "Providing for Future Generations," is raising funds to refresh and remodel the Community Room and adjoining restrooms, as well as improve the functionality of the center by connecting the building to natural gas lines and replacing part of the aging roof.

BUILDING COMMUNITY

To date, more than \$525,000 has been raised in support of the project.

“We have been thrilled with the generous response of many community donors to our early outreach,” said Bill Morral, campaign co-chair.

The Generations campaign launch celebrated the support of several major donors already committed to the project. In honor of their strong support, two spaces within the Center were renamed for generous donors: The Charles H. Allebach, Jr. Community Room and the Univest Meals on Wheels Kitchen. In addition, several local dignitaries attended the campaign launch and voiced their support of our programs and our project.

We now hope to engage Generations Participants and the community at large to help reach our million dollar fundraising goal. Work on the project will begin once fundraising is complete and is targeted for Spring 2020.

The project is focused on improvements to the Community Room where a daily congregate meal is served to more than 80 senior community residents. It will also benefit families, groups, and companies that use the Center for parties, weddings, and meetings year-round. Even the Meals On Wheels Program that serves meals to more than 200 homebound adults per day will benefit from the conversion of kitchen appliances to more efficient and cost-effective gas units.

Generations of Indian Valley is a private, nonprofit, 501(c)(3) organization founded in 1967 as the Senior Adult Activity Center of Indian Valley. Generations of Indian Valley provides valuable services that improve the quality of life of seniors by providing nutritional meals and activities that reduce isolation and enable them to remain in their homes and as independent as possible.
