Biltmore's Candlelight Christmas

5 Days December 7-11, 2026

Day 1 – Natural Bridge, VA – Today, travel to Natural Bridge, VA on a deluxe motorcoach from Starr Tours. Check into The Natural Bridge Historic Hotel & Conference Center for a one-night stay. Enjoy a getaway in the gorgeous Shenandoah Valley surrounded by the majestic Blue Ridge Mountains with a stay at Natural Bridge Hotel. Dinner is included this evening at the hotel. **(D)**

Day 2 – Asheville, NC – Biltmore Candlelight Christmas Dinner – Biltmore Candlelight Christmas Evening Tour – After breakfast, depart for Asheville, NC where you will arrive this afternoon. Day 3 – Biltmore Estate Tour – Antler Hill Village – Biltmore Wine Tasting – Asheville Museum of History - Free Evening – After breakfast this morning, meet your local guide for a day of touring. Today, you will again visit the Biltmore Estate with a local guide. The Biltmore House is America's largest privately owned home and, on this tour, you will cross the threshold into a world of beauty virtually unchanged for more than a century. Explore grand spaces filled with masterpieces of art and stunning antiques. Plus, Christmas decorations seen by daylight give you a whole different view.

Visit Antler Village, a recreation that connects the estate's past and present with dining, shopping, and exhibits. Lunch is on your own. You will also get a chance to visit the Biltmore Winery. Delight in free wine tastings and a redesigned self-guided tour to learn how the award-winning wines are made.

This afternoon, visit the Asheville Museum of History which tells stories of the mountains, a region with a rich and diverse—and sometimes misunderstood—past. Enjoy an introductory presentation about the history of the Smith-McDowell House, which the Asheville Museum of History resides within. Explore the museum, which has an expanded focus of history within the Western North Carolina Region.

Tonight, enjoy a free evening and dinner on your own. The hotel has a wonderful Rooftop Restaurant and Bar, plus many restaurants within walking distance. **(B)**

Day 4 - Harrisonburg, VA - After breakfast at the hotel, travel to Harrisonburg, VA where you enjoy an overnight stay at the Courtyard by Marriott. Dinner is on your own this evening. Enjoy the hotel restaurant and walkable options close to the hotel. **(B)**
